



SIZING GUIDE

Welcome to the King Rings Family!

Sizing is important and we are pleased to help you find the best possible fit with an experience akin to a tailor-fitting.

Wash your sizing rings with warm, soapy water. Nothing has been done to them since they left the 3D Print bed, a cleaning can't hurt. The rings are body safe PLA plastic but we can't vouch for their cleanliness, treat accordingly.

A small piece of sandpaper has been included, this can be used to smooth rough spots which sometimes result from the printing process.

Please take time to fully test drive your Sizing Rings, we want you to be 100% confident in the high quality, metal ring(s) you eventually purchase.

1. GET IT ON

Put Sizing Rings on While Flaccid

COCK RINGS

It can take a little practice to get comfortable with this process. The larger the ring, the easier it is, so start big and work your way down.

1. Hold the ring beneath your scrotum and use the other hand to pull one testicle down through the ring.
2. From above, push the second testicle down through the ring.
3. Fold your penis downward, tuck the head through the ring and then pull it from the other side until you are completely through the ring.

A dab of lube on the head of your penis may help with the last step. Better still, try this in the shower or with a dry lubricant like talcum powder.

GLANS RINGS

A glans ring sits just behind the head of the penis and getting one on is a bit more intuitive than a cock ring.

Slip the head of your penis through the ring and maybe grasp it from the other side, if you are able to grab it with your finger tips, and pull it through.

A little lubrication can help but too much might frustrate your efforts. It gets easier with practice.

2. SAFETY CHECK

The Three Finger Rule of Thumb (Cock Rings)

The Three Finger Rule of Thumb is a good sanity check before things get hard. Some guys who are new to rigid rings fear getting trapped and this offers some practical reassurance by creating expectations of “probable” outcome. This assessment alone is not enough to find your best fit, do not skip Step 3.

With your palm facing up, hook your index finger under the top/front edge of the ring and work it toward you, beneath the band and all the way up to, but not including, your second knuckle. This should not require any lube. That’s the one finger test. Start over for the 2 and 3 finger tests with fingers side by side, pads facing up. What is your max finger count?



1 FINGER: Tight fit and may result in aggressive restriction of blood flow while erect. It may be difficult to lose the erection, which will happen slowly. In terms of hardness, this ring size may give you the maximum effect but at the possible expense of your own pleasure.



2 FINGERS: Firm fit and will likely result in moderate restriction of blood flow. This size may give your erection a gentle but noticeable boost; harder and more persistent. Some discoloration is normal, the state of your erection will follow the state of your arousal.



3 FINGERS: Loose fit and easier to put on and remove. You will look and feel great wearing a King Ring this size but it may not give your erection much benefit. Super comfortable when erect and without much discoloration. Not a good choice for casual wear as it may work its way off, then down and out your pant leg. In other words, an excellent conversation starter.

3. TESTING

IMPORTANT: Performance Testing

The 2mm difference in sizes is the width of a grain of rice and can make size selection seem difficult. Thankfully, you have a consistent and objective measuring tool, your erection. If you plan to wear just one ring both casually and during playtime, this step is critical.

It may seem counter intuitive but the size you are looking to identify is the ring which is too small. Pick a 2 or 3 finger size and wear it through a complete sexual cycle to see how it performs. If it does not cause an uncomfortable experience then move down a size and repeat. Keep doing this until you find a size which you recognize as too small. It is nearly impossible to get trapped this way unless you shoot way past the uncomfortable size. Once you know which size is too small, you'll know your best size is one size larger.

The best fit for a glans ring is more a matter of preference than safety. Ideally, the ring should be snug enough to stay in place behind the head of your penis while worn casually—keeping in mind our metal rings are heavy—but not so tight as to cause discomfort while erect.

Bonus! Larger sized rings may work for you as a shaft ring (further up the penis) or even stacked behind a smaller ring at the head.

Important: Some discoloration is normal but you want to avoid a purple, throbbing monster. Once you notice a color change, do not remain fully erect in the ring for longer than about 20 minutes. Remain aware of your condition and do not wear while sleeping.

King Rings Look Great on Fingers Too!

Your secret bling doesn't need to be a total secret. A teeny tiny version of your favorite cock ring placed prominently on your hand is an excellent conversation piece. Find your size:

1. Close the ring tool by placing tab end through the buckle end.
2. Adjust ring to desired size. Full number should be visible, see example above with tool adjusted to size 12.
3. Slip sizing tool onto your finger and over the knuckle without allowing it to slip larger. Remove ring the same way.
4. Adjust size up or down and repeat until you find an appropriate fit.

Note: King Rings offers whole sizes only, no half sizes are currently available.
